Because 8% is 4/5 of 10%, the tax is 5/4 of one part of the whole bar. Each part of the whole bar is \$8. So, the sales tax is 5/4 of \$8. 4/5 x \$8 = \$6.40. The sales tax is \$6.40. Step 2 : To find the total cost of the jacket, add the price of the jacket and the sales tax. Jacket price + Sales tax = Total cost. \$80 + \$6.40 = \$86.40
