Through his application of a limited palette on distressed wood, his handmade wooden frames, and his expressive use of Latin text, Diaz's images thrust us into another time and place.

In Soul of Science, Daniel Martin Diaz examines the mysteries of scientific diagrams, secrets of symbols and their everlasting effect on the human psyche.
