Torna in una nuova edizione, aggiornata e ampliata, Sex and Violence, un viaggio in tutto ciò che è estremo al cinema, dai primordi ai giorni nostri: immagini e pellicole oscene, immorali, violente, scioccanti, proibite. Con un approccio trasversale e curioso, privo di pregiudizi e aperto a riflessioni sociologiche, gli autori analizzano cinema d'autore e di genere, arte e pornografia, Occidente e Oriente: l'America puritana e moralista del Codice Hays e la nascita degli horror splatter, l'esplosione dell'hardcore e le provocazioni di autori come Robbe-Grillet, Zulawski, Borowczyk, figure di culto come Jesús Franco, Alberto Cavallone e Jos. The Naples-born director and screenwriter Paolo Sorrentino has, to date, written and directed nine films, winning an Oscar, a Bafta and a Golden Globe for The Great Beauty in 2013. In 2016, he created and directed his first TV series, The Young Pope, which starred Jude Law. John Malkovich joined the cast in 2020 for the follow-up series. He has established himself as a world-leading auteur with a list of critically acclaimed and award-winning films. This is an invaluable contribution to the existing literature on Sorrentino and is the first English language collection dedicated to this prolific director, who has emerged as one of the most compelling figures in twenty-first-century European film. International contributors from the UK, Italy, France, The Netherlands, Australia, Israel, Canada and the United States, Italy, Israel, France, UK, Australia, Canada, offer original interpretations of Sorrentino's work. They examine his recurrent grand themes of memory, nostalgia, ageing, love, thirst for fulfilment, search for the self, identity crisis, human estrangement, marginality, irony and power. In so doing, they offer new perspectives and unique cues for discussion, challenging established assumptions and interpretations. Important and current themes such as eco-cinema and post-secularism are addressed as well as the links between Sorrentino's highly visual cinema and artistic practice such as painting and architecture. While there are several books on Sorrentino available in Italian, none of these provide an authoritative account of his work; and language has restricted the readership. This is the first English-language collection focussed on Sorrentino, arguably the most successful and significant contemporary Italian filmmaker. The majority of the chapters included in this new book are original and it also includes a Foreword by Giancarlo Lombardi, Professor of Italian and Comparative Literature at CUNY, and an interview with renowned costume designer Carlo Poggioli, who has worked with Sorrentino on many productions. Some of the chapters were previously published in a special issue of the journal JICMS - The Journal of Italian Cinema and Media Studies in 2019. The new collection makes a significant coherent contribution to the field. Primary readership will be academics, researchers and scholars of Italian film and media studies. 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subject, there is a possibility for some crossover appeal to a broader readership, but this is primarily a scholarly text.

Il '68 e tutto ciò che da esso è nato - la controcultura, il pacifismo, la rivoluzione dei costumi, la sessualità libera - hanno cambiato profondamente il cinema. Il mondo aveva fame di emozioni forti, di dissacrazione, di trasgressione e il cinema, in un certo senso, si incaricò di soddisfare questa esigenza. Ma il '68 non riuscì a cambiare la censura, almeno in Italia. Nonostante non potesse prescindere dall'aria nuova che si respirava, essa si mostrò falsamente liberale nelle decisioni e di fatto prigioniera di una normativa che, nonostante lunghe trattative con produttori o distributori, portò spesso al sequestro delle pellicole da parte della magistratura. Tra la realtà, in rapidissima evoluzione, e la sua comprensione da parte delle aule di tribunale, legate a canoni obsoleti e inconsistenti, si era aperto uno iato impossibile da colmare. Fu proprio in questo clima di continui sequestri che nacquero i primi cinema a «luci rosse» e le conseguenti crociate contro il porno. Ma come si è evoluta la censura italiana dopo il boom dei film per adulti, dagli anni '80 ai giorni nostri? In quali forme e secondo quali criteri agisce? E in che misura interviene ancora a regolare e condizionare le produzioni odierne? Anche questo volume - come il primo dedicato agli anni 1947-1968 - è diviso in due sezioni, una di taglio storiografico, l'altra costituita dalle schede dettagliate di tutte le pellicole bocciate (con l'indicazione puntuale dei tagli effettuati e delle manipolazioni richieste dai censori).

La morte è oggi uno degli elementi più ricorrenti dell'immaginario visivo occidentale. Se da una parte la comunicazione audiovisiva tende a presentare il cadavere come un oggetto spettacolare, dall'altra esso è diventato una posta in gioco cruciale nell'arena politica, in particolare a seguito della circolazione internazionale di alcuni video dello Stato Islamico. Se è vero che la teoria del cinema si interroga da tempo sull'idea-limite del filmare la morte e che pare esistere a livello antropologico una connessione profonda fra l'atto di prendere un'immagine e quello di togliere la vita, urge costruire una cornice teorica coerente che sia in grado di interrogare la complessità del fenomeno, tracciando genealogie impreviste ed evitando facili semplificazioni: offrendo un punto di vista nuovo e fortemente interdisciplinare su questo intricato insieme di questioni.

Acclaimed film scholar Francesco Casetti situates the cinematic experience within discourses of 20th century modernity. He suggests that film defined a unique gaze not only because it recorded many of the centuries most important events, but also because it determined the manner in which they were received.

In 1968, George Romero's film Night of the Living Dead premiered, launching a growing preoccupation with zombies within mass and literary fiction, film, television, and video games. Romero's creativity and enduring influence make him a worthy object of inquiry in his own right, and his long career helps us take stock of the shifting interest in zombies since the 1960s. Examining his work promotes a better understanding of the current state of the zombie and where it is going amidst the political and social turmoil of the twenty-first century. These new essays document, interpret, and explain the meaning of the still-budding Romero legacy, drawing cross-disciplinary perspectives from such fields as literature, political science, philosophy, and comparative film studies. Essays consider some of the sources of Romero's inspiration (including comics, science fiction, and Westerns), chart his influence as a storyteller and a social critic, and consider the legacy he leaves for viewers, artists, and those studying the living dead.
