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SOLUTIONS OF SELECTED PROBLEMS Problem 36, p. 63 If $\mu(E_n) < \infty$ and $E_n \subset E_{n+1}$ in L^1 , then f is a.e. equal to a characteristic function of a measurable set. Solution: By Corollary 2.32, there exists a subsequence $E_{n_j} \subset E_{n_{j+1}}$ a.e.. Let $A = \{x : \lim_{j \rightarrow \infty} \chi_{E_{n_j}}(x) = 1\}$. For $x \in A$, $\{\chi_{E_{n_j}}(x)\}$ is a sequence of 0's and 1's, so its limit can be either 0 or 1.

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
