Diabetes in children and teens: Symptoms and diagnosis  
People with type 1 diabetes are usually diagnosed when they are under 10. Type 1 diabetes happens when the body does not produce enough insulin. This means that glucose produced in the breakdown of food (digestion) stays in the blood. Following diagnosis with type 1 diabetes, the body requires insulin injections, or insulin using an insulin pump.

Type 1 Diabetes and Children  
If your child has already been diagnosed with type 1 diabetes, call your doctor if you notice any of these signs of a low blood sugar emergency: Blurry or double vision Cold, clammy skin Confusion Dizziness Drowsiness or tiredness Extreme or sudden hunger Headache Pale, moist skin Rapid pulse ...

There are several blood tests for type 1 diabetes in children: Random blood sugar test. This is the primary screening test for type 1 diabetes. A blood sample is taken at a random time. A blood sugar level of 200 milligrams per deciliter (mg/dL), or 11.1 millimoles per liter (mmol/L), or higher suggests diabetes. Glycated hemoglobin (A1C) test.
